- Disadvantage such as financial hardship means cost to family is a burden
- Cricket Australia Diversity target areas: Female cricketers, Indigenous cricketers

- 1. Club Name and Name of Nominator
- 2. Name of the young cricketer nominated for the Award
- 3. Age Group(s) the young cricketer is playing in during current season
- 4. Award category
- 5. Brief description of the cricketer's contribution to their team and cricket club
